LISTENING:

- Determines main idea and details of extended discussion of familiar and unfamiliar topics
- Makes inferences from oral discourse containing satire, sarcasm, or humor
- Identifies and reacts to subtle differences in speech and register (hyperbole, satires, comedy, etc.)
- Makes personal connections from listening to oral discourse

SPEAKING:

- Gives oral presentations on grade-level topics using multimedia
- Uses expanded vocabulary and includes details to tell, retell, or elaborate on a story or event with accuracy
- Expresses a clear position (explicit or implied) and includes various forms of information to clearly support that position (personal experience, observation, fact, other sources)

READING:

- Analyzes and critiques materials and sources
- Identifies evidence of bias and credibility of a source
- Synthesizes grade-level expository text
- Reads a variety of grade-level texts independently for different purposes

WRITING:

- Produces research reports using multiple resources and citations
- Authors a variety of forms and genres for multiple audiences
- Uses complex sentence structures and self-edits for syntax and grammar
- Effectively incorporates the six traits of writing: ideas, organization, voice, word choice, sentence fluency, and conventions
